To make Loo Roll Tube flowers you will need:

- ★ 2 loo roll tubes
- ★ Pencil
- ★ Scissors
- ★ Crayons
- ★ Tape, we used paper tape
- ★ Glue, we made our own rice glue for sustainability (see our Rice Glue recipe to make your own).
- ★ Thin sticks. We used pea sticks for plant care.





1: Flatten the tubes. Mark the centre and then the centre of the two sections and cut. This gives 8 rings. You need 6 but can add extra petals.



2: Colour 6 - 1 green, 5 chosen petal colour/s. They don't all need to be the same. Remember to do both sides.



3: Tape 2 together near the fold. Then keep adding petals until round to first. Flip over and tape all joins.



4: Dip the stick in glue and insert between 2 petals.



5: Cut the green one in half fold to fold, to give 2 leaves.



6: Tape the leaves to the stick and you are done.
