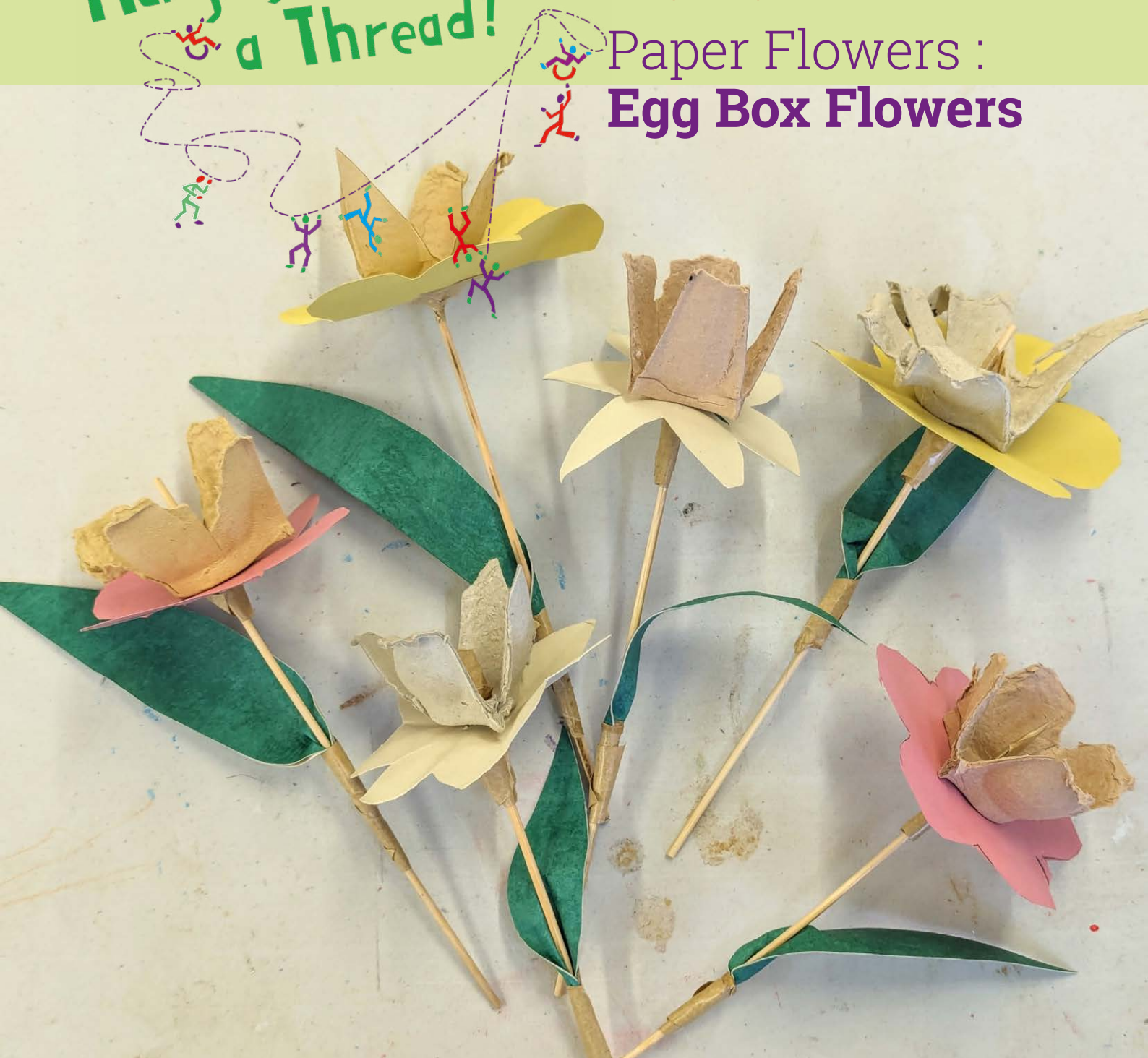

## To make Egg Box Flowers you will need:

- ★ an egg box
- ★ coloured card (including green for the leaves)
- ★ pencil
- ★ scissors
- ★ Tape, we used paper tape
- ★ Thin sticks. We used pea sticks for plant care.



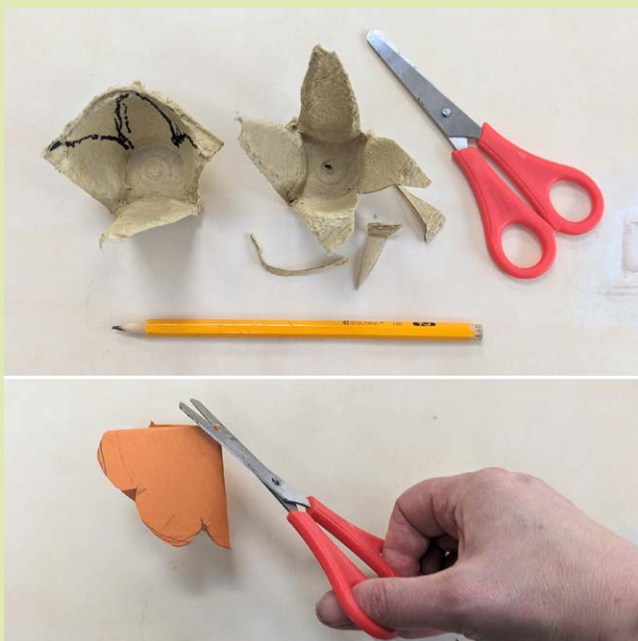




**1:** Cut the bottom part of the egg box into 6 pieces along the joins.



**2:** Draw a flower on coloured card & cut out (I use my tape as a useful size guide)



**3:** Shape 1 of the egg box pieces and make hole using pencil. Fold flower to find centre and snip.



**4:** Tape the tip of the stick. Slide on the egg box and flower shape. Secure with tape.



**5:** Cut a leaf shape from the green card. (As these look a bit like daffodils, I go with a long shape.)



**6:** Tape the leaf to the stick and you are done.
